The 9 Lazio publishers featured in this catalogue and at the Frankfurter Buchmesse are just a small sample of the approximately 300 active publishing houses in Lazio, which account for 17% of the national total amount, and 10 thousand printed titles for a total of 11.3 million copies, according to the data provided by the Italian Publishers Association. Such numbers are proof of the strength and dynamism of a sector that not only is a fundamental part of a continuously growing business and production sector, but it is also and above all a "service" aimed at citizens, a tool that fosters free information, the circulation of ideas and the social and cultural growth of our community. Lazio Region invests on the strength of culture, on the power of books and on the vitality of the small and medium-sized publishing enterprises that promote culture. We want to support them at local and, most importantly, national and international level.

We put into practice a specific program aimed at supporting the internationalization of our publishing sector, not only helping small and medium-sized cultural enterprises of Rome and Lazio to participate in the most important international Trade Fairs, but also through grants and incentives to support publications and publishing projects in reaching foreign markets. Lazio Region is also strongly committed to digitalization, which allowed enterprises to modernize their production processes, for an increasingly technological and modern publishing production. Specific actions, therefore, to support a sector that is the flagship of Lazio and to grant the talent, ideas and cultural projects of our region the opportunity to become successful stories and books. 66THAND2ND

66thand2nd was launched in 2009 with two series, Attese and Bazar. Later the Bookclub and Vite inattese series were launched. 66thand2nd focuses on sports literature and emerging BAME authors. In Attese we have published classics such as "Shoeless Joe", by S.W. Kinsella and "On Boxing" by J.C. Oates. Bazar hosts authors like Alain Mabanckou, Dany Laferrière. Bookclub, dedicated to reading groups, hosts authors like Mark Z. Danielewski, Antoine Volodine and Margo Jefferson. Vite inattese was launched to focus on sports memoirs and includes works such as "Barbarian Days" by William Finnegan and "Showboat - The Life of Kobe Bryant" by Roland Lazenby.

All Around

All Around Editions, founded by a group of journalists, proposes itself as a generalist publishing house (storytelling, fiction, childhood, audio-library) particularly noteworthy in terms of memory and civil rights. Born in 2014, All Around has established itself in the Roman and Italian national scene as a publishing house capable of combining in-depth study with entertainment. Over 100 authors surround the founding nucleus, offering an ever-updated cross-section of Italian memory and feeling. Finally, All around enjoys important institutional partnerships, starting with the Paolo Murialdi Foundation for Journalism.

Carlo Gallucci Editore

Gallucci editore was founded in Rome in 2002. Started as a family adventure, it is now a mid- to big size independent publisher with several imprints. Gallucci publishes books for children and young readers written and illustrated by prestigious authors and artists (and some musicians as well, as there is a focus on music books, even with sound chips), both Italian and international ones. Many titles are also non-fiction, with a particular interest in STEM subjects. Since 2017 Gallucci Librido publishes “hybrid” books: cloth books, bath books, with toys, gadgets and cards. Since 2018 Gallucci Kalimat publishes bilingual (Italian-Arabic) picture books and novels to favour communication between Mediterranean cultures. Gallucci Bros. gathers the “brossure” (books in paperback format) – middle grade and YA novels, and there is also a growing adults’ list. Gallucci Balloon (comics and graphic novels for all ages, both literary and underground) has been launched in December 2022.
