WELCOME TO LAZIO

REGION OF ROME, HEART OF EUROPE AND CENTRE OF THE MEDITERRANEAN AREA

Lazio boasts a geopolitical position of global importance: in the heart of Europe and at the centre of the Mediterranean region, a crossroad with the Middle East and South-East Asia.

Lazio is the 2nd Italian Region for Gross Domestic Product (GDP) with 186 BN euros, contributing to 11.3% to Italian national GDP.

Lazio is the Italian Region with the highest level of specialization in manufacturing and in high-tech knowledge-intensive sectors.

Lazio's share of exports in global leading sectors is twice the national average (in percentage terms 72% vs 32%).

2 International Airports

Civitavecchia Port is the major Italian touristic port, the 2nd in Europe and the 7th in the world for number of passengers (3 million per year, pre-pandemic data). It boasts It boasts the handling of 10 million tons of goods a year (pre-pandemic data).






LAZIO MAIN PARTNERS AND PRODUCTS

Top 20 countries where Lazio has exported goods in 2020






TRADE EXCHANGE LAZIO - EMIRATES

Top 10 goods exported from Lazio to Emirates in 2020



IMPROVING POST-PANDEMIC PERFORMANCE BY PUBLIC INVESTMENT

Latest data show a well performing economy:

- GDP increased by 5.3% in Jan-June 2021 compared to the same period of 2020
- Export increased by 10.9% during the period Jan-Sept 2021 compared to the same period of 2020

A massive 15.2 BN public investment plan has been established in order to boost the recovery.

The regional GDP is expected to increase by 2.6% (yearly average in the period 2022-2024).

LAZIO PLAYS A SIGNIFICANT INTERNATIONAL ROLE IN THE INDUSTRY OF AEROSPACE, AERONAUTICS, SPACE ECONOMY AND SECURITY, BOTH IN THE MANUFACTURING INDUSTRY AND FOR SPECIFIC SKILLS IN TECHNOLOGICAL SERVICES AND R&D.

Lazio is the only Italian Region which **hosts the whole aerospace value chain**. Important big groups of international excellence in electronics, sensors, avionics, components and innovative materials, "space" and satellite applications and services, are located in the Region.

LAZIO AEROSPACE TECHNOLOGY DISTRICT was established in 2004 by a Framework Agreement signed by Italy Ministry of Research and Lazio Region. In 2012, the DTA of Lazio was one of the founding partners of the Italian National Cluster for Aerospace Technology.

ESA BIC (Business Incubation Centre) Lazio is a partnership between the Lazio Region, ASI (Italian Space Agency) and ESA (European Space Agency).

NEW SPACE ECONOMY OSE SCONOMY



TODAY LAZIO IS A SPACE ECONOMY HUB CAPABLE OF TRANSFERRING THE BENEFITS OF SPACE TECHNOLOGIES TO CITIZENS, BUSINESSES, LOCAL COMMUNITIES AND TERRITORIES.

Space technologies can be applied to: developing agriculture, monitoring the environment and hydrogeological risk, emergency prevention, air traffic control and improving telecommunications services. Lazio companies are at the forefront in two important European programs linked to space and earth observation:





COPERNICUS, the European Union's Earth Observation Programme. It provides accurate, timely and easily accessible information that enables the monitoring of the Earth, marine and atmospheric environments.

e-GEOS and Telespazio are among the major industrial partners of the Programme involved in the space component ground segment development and operations in emergency management, land and sea safety management, land resource management, and the monitoring of climate change.



GALILEO (2nd Generation), the **European Union's global satellite** navigation system (GNSS), is one of the greatest and most ambitious European projects born from the collaboration of the European **Union** with the European Space Agency (ESA) to create a global navigation satellite system. Italy has had a major role since the very beginning of the Galileo programme, first of all, through the Italian Space Agency (ASI), and secondly, through the involvement of the Italian industry and, in particular, of the Leonardo Group.



ESA-ESRIN, located in Frascati (Lazio) is the European centre of excellence for exploitation of Earth observation missions. The mission and payload operations of ESA's Earth observation satellites are managed here, and ESRIN is the primary source for the acquisition, distribution, and exploitation of data from these and other non-ESA satellites.



ASI - The Italian Space Agency, born in 1988, is a national public body supervised by the Ministry of Education, University and Research that cooperates with several other departments. It has established itself as one of the most important global stakeholders on the scene of space science, satellite technologies and development of means to reach and explore the cosmos. Today the Italian Space Agency plays a leading role both at a European level, where Italy is the third major contributor to the European Space Agency, and at a global level.

Over the last years, **BIOTECHNOLOGY** has expanded to include new and diverse sciences, such as GENOMICS, RECOMBINANT GENE techniques, applied IMMUNOLOGY, and the development of PHARMACEUTICAL therapies and DIAGNOSTIC TESTS. It includes also the commitment to health to create **vaccines**, such as that against Covid-19.



Particularly important is the concentration of companies of the automotive supply chain in the industrial area of Cassino (Frosinone). The development of this strategic area began in 1972 with FIAT. The site, which covers an area of over 2 million square meters, is the largest FCA plant in Italy, only equal to the Mirafiori site in Turin.



TOURISM: A POST-PANDEMIC STRATEGIC SECTOR

Tourism will play a strategic role IN the recovery of the regional economy.

All forecast show the return to growth in 2022 and Lazio will be again the most important tourist destinations and Rome will get the highest market share of the total tourist number in Italy.
