WHY LAZIO

Lazio boasts a geopolitical position of global importance: in the heart of Europe and at the center of the Mediterranean region, a crossroad towards the Middle East and South-East Asia.

Lazio is the 2nd Italian Region for Gross Domestic Product (GDP) with 239 Bn euros (2023), contributing to 11% of Italian national GDP.

Lazio is the Italian Region with the highest level of specialization in manufacturing and in high-tech knowledge intensive sectors.

Lazio's share of exports in global leading sectors is twice the national average (in percentage terms 72% vs 32%).







LAZIO, A CONNECTED REGION

LAZIO REGION IS A STRATEGIC LOGISTICAL PLATFORM IN ITALY AND EUROPE



2 International Airports

(Fiumicino and Ciampino, over 50 million passengers per year). Fiumicino Leonardo Da Vinci Airport is the first stopover in Italy and the first European airport in terms of traveler satisfaction.



Civitavecchia Port is the major Italian cruise port, the 2nd in Europe and 7th in the world for number of passengers (3 million per year). It boasts the handling 10 million tons of goods a year.



2 main railway stations (Termini and Tiburtina) which guarantee high speed rail connections with all major Italian and European cities. Lazio is part of the Trans-European Networks - Transport (TEN-T).



Main Highways: A1 Milano-Roma-Napoli, A12 Roma-Civitavecchia, A24 Roma-L'Aquila. The extension of the road network in Lazio Region consists of approximately 10 thousand kilometers, of which 473 are motorways and 553 national roads.

Rome, with over **20** million **tourists a year**, is the most visited city in Italy and one of the most visited in the world.





LAZIO BOASTS AN EXTREMELY IMPORTANT AND CONSOLIDATED AUTOMOTIVE SECTOR. THE REGIONAL ENGINEERING INDUSTRY CONSISTS OF HUNDREDS OF SMEs LINKED TO THE FULL SUPPLY CHAIN, IN PARTICULAR TO COMPONENTS PRODUCTION.

Particularly important is the concentration of companies of the **automotive supply chain** in the **industrial area of Cassino (Frosinone).** The development of this strategic area began in 1972 with FIAT. The site, which covers an area of over 2 million square meters, is **the largest FCA plant in Italy**, only equal to the Mirafiori site in Turin.

1. All Roads lead to Rome

- Rome is the capital of Italy and Lazio region
- Hosts 209 diplomatic missions and 85 diplomatic representations of the Vatican
- · Home to the Vatican City, Basilica of St. Peter, Vatican Museums, and Sistine Chapel
- Headquarters of international organizations (i.e.FAO, IFAD)

2. Top economy

- Italy: 8th largest world economy, 3rd largest in Europe, GDP worth 1.8 trillion
- Lazio: 2nd Italian region for GDP, worth EUR 239 billion
- Market opportunities with a population of over 5 million and GDP per capita of 32,440 EUR
- Strong and sustainable economic growth, 1st region in Italy for employment growth and reducing greenhouse gas emissions

3. Strategic logistic hub

- Italy: Strategic gateway to 500 million consumers in the EU and 270 million in Northern Africa and the Middle East
- 40 major ports and 42 airports, linking southern Europe to central and eastern Europe
- Lazio: Region of the Capital Rome, heart of Europe, and center of the Mediterranean Area
- Global geopolitical importance, 2 international airports and 1 major port
- Well-connected to Milan and Naples by highway

4. Key manufacturing player

- Italy: 2nd largest manufacturing economy in Europe, 5th largest globally, EUR 516 billion in goods exports in 2021
- 18,000 enterprises in the machinery and equipment sector, ranking 1st in Europe by the number of companies
- · Lazio: Highest specialization in manufacturing and high-tech knowledge-intensive sectors in Italy
- 72% share of exports in global leading sectors, twice the national average (32%)

5. Competitiveness

- Italy: Access to unique expertise in leading sectors such as machinery, robotics, design, pharmaceuticals, fashion, and food
- Extensive networks of SMEs and manufacturing clusters throughout the country
- Lazio: 2nd Italian region for innovative startups
- Main products exported: pharmaceuticals (47% of total), vehicles (10% of total), chemicals, metals, textiles, machinery, electronics, and food

Skilled workforce and Talent pool
